### **A. COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This is the first of two classes designed to provide information and additional instruction in editing techniques. Students will begin with placing text in pictures and in talk bubbles. Emphasis will be placed in utilizing the techniques learned in previous classes, especially *layering* techniques. Participants will start with obtaining photo(s) from a specified file, building a photo catalog, examining ways to enhance a photo and saving the photo(s) to a specific file. Photos edited in this class will be used in the follow-on workshop (**Students should bring a flash drive (at least 512MB) to save his/her work**).

### **B. METHOD OF INSTRUCTION**

Lecture, discussion, question and answer, demonstration, hands-on computer use related to the course and student demonstration of course related tasks.

### **C. COURSE OBJECTIVES**

Objective 1: Students will successfully demonstrate inserting text in pictures and talk bubbles.

Objective 2: Students will successfully demonstrate the ability to obtain photos from specified files and build a photo catalog.

Objective 3: Students will successfully demonstrate methods to enhance photos and save the photos to specific files.

Objective 4: Students will successfully demonstrate the ability to save files to a flash drive.
