A. COURSE DESCRIPTION

We will look at the “*create*” function of Photoshop Elements. Photos saved in the Albums I class will be used to create a photo album. Students will learn how to add photos to an album, arrange the photos in the desired sequence, add text as desired and save the finished product to a PDF file. The class will also examine methods of creating a slide show, calendars and cards. Information will also be provided to enable participants to create a studio style portrait.

B. METHOD OF INSTRUCTION

Lecture, discussion, question and answer, demonstration, hands-on computer use related to the course and student demonstration of course related tasks.

C. COURSE OBJECTIVES

Objective 1: Students will successfully demonstrate the ability to access files from a flash drive.

Objective 2: Students will successfully demonstrate the ability to add photos to an album, arrange the photos in a desired sequence and add text to the photo.

Objective 3: Students will successfully demonstrate the ability to save their photo product to a PDF file.

Objective 4: Students will successfully demonstrate the ability to create a slide show, calendar and cards and create a studio style portrait.
