A. Course Description:

This class will use the free software Picasa to help students learn how to quickly organize and edit your photos with the greatest of ease.. Students may bring their own photos on a CD or Flash Drive and use them for this class. You may also bring your own laptop. This class is for those who love inexpensive simplicity and ease with photo editing.

B. Method of Instruction:

This course uses mainly hands-on computer use - See one, Do one! Lecture, demonstration, discussion, question and answer as related to the course and the students will demonstrate course related tasks.

C. Course Objectives:

Objective 1. Students will learn how to download the free photo editing software of Picasa.

Objective 2. Students will successfully demonstrate basic editing techniques such as cropping, enhancing, removing red eye, using filters and using the text tool.

Objective 3. Students will successfully demonstrate the process of making a photo collage.

Objective 4. Students will successfully demonstrate the ability to make a slide show with effects, animation and inserting music while using Picasa. They will also learn how to upload to the web, place photos on a map to identify where they took them and email from Picasa.
